The study program in History and Archaeology encompasses advanced knowledge in history and archaeology. The multidisciplinary study of theory and applied aspects within this academic program will aid in finding solutions to contemporary challenges in Macedonian history and archaeology across all their segments. This is due to the rich historical and archaeological heritage that Macedonia, as a geostrategic center in the Balkans, rightfully deserves. This space, from prehistoric times to the present day, is a crossroads of all world civilizations and cultures, evidenced by remains on the ground. The goal of this study program is to prepare professionals such as history professors in primary and secondary schools, archaeologists, members of expert teams in archives, libraries, expert services in various institutions, diplomacy, museums, cultural centers, military schools, numerous scientific research institutions, etc. Students are provided with various techniques for working with historical texts, archaeological material, and illustrative material, enabling them to conduct independent analyses, interpret historical documents, and evaluate different interpretations.

The program is based on historical events, cultural processes, and phenomena from general, world, and national history, which represent fundamental values for understanding the cultural and civilizational development of humanity.
