The conference will take place at the main conference room at the **Faculty of Educational Sciences at the Goce Delcev University of Shtip**, on the **15<sup>th</sup> of May, 2019**. Each of the participants will have an allocated time slot of 15 minutes to present their paper.

Students that wish to participate are obliged to send an abstract for their topic of choice by 30<sup>th</sup> of April 2019, in Macedonian or English. # Rules for preparing the paper:

# Structure of the paper

- Main title in large letter, bold, 12;
- Name and surname of the author/co-authors, bold, 12;
- Abstract in Macedonian or English (no more than 250 words);
- 3-5 Keywords;
- Introduction;
- Main part;
- Conclusion;
- Bibliography.

# Preparing the paper

The paper should be prepared by the following rules: written in Macedonian or English in MS Word, A4 format, using Arial in a font size of 12, with 1.5 paragraph spacing in Justify, the margins of the documents should be 2.54 and each of the pages should be numbered.

#### <u>References</u>

The bibliography should be given in alphabetical order by the authors' names. Should more of the same author's book be included, the latest work is required to be at the top whereas the oldest one at the end.
